

We are making some changes to our bus services across North Yorkshire and East Riding of Yorkshire from 5th January 2025.

Key features of these changes include:

- Abbots Road estate will benefit from earlier journeys to Selby, following requests from the community and local councillors. Service 401 will divert around the estate from 5 January instead of service 476. This also means new connections from Abbots Road estate to Goole.
- Camblesforth, Snaith and Rawcliffe will benefit from a later trip on service 401 following a request made by one of our customers at the recent Bus Surgery meeting.
- Staynor Hall estate will benefit from being reconnected to the bus network following requests made at the recent Bus Surgery meeting. The previous service 5 ended when the developer funding came to an end. From 5 January, service 8 will operate this diversion. We are also taking on the feedback raised at the Bus Surgery and we are preparing to cover more of the estate, subject to a satisfactory Route Risk Assessment which will be undertaken with our Trade Union colleagues shortly.
- Thorpe Willoughby will benefit from buses diverting via Fox Lane and Field Lane. Buses will now continue along Barff Lane to/from Selby providing new links to Selby War Memorial Hospital. This change is made following requests from the community and the MP.
- Brayton will benefit from double the number of buses, with services running to/from Selby up to every 30 minutes Monday to Saturday daytime, as well as a direct hourly link to Leeds for the first time.
- Hambleton, Monk Fryston and South Milford will benefit from more direct buses to Leeds as most service 64 journeys become service 164 journeys instead, following requests from the community.
- Sherburn-in-Elmet will benefit from most service 164 journeys running direct to Leeds via Micklefield and Garforth, instead of serving the Industrial Estate first, following requests from the community. We will still run journeys to/from the Industrial Estate at key shift change times.

The full list of service changes is as follows:

8 Selby - Staynor Hall - Barlow - Camblesforth - Drax

Following requests from the community, and because of other changes being made across the network, we are now able to divert service 8 via Staynor Hall estate. A new timetable will be introduced to accommodate the extra journey time needed to divert buses this way.

42 York - Naburn - Stillingfleet - Cawood - Selby

The Saturday 10:13, 11:13 and 12:13 journeys from Stillingfleet to York are seasonal journeys to provide extra capacity when Naburn Lock Caravan Park is open. These journeys do not run off-season.

64 Sherburn Industrial Estate - Sherburn-in-Elmet - South Milford - Monk Fryston - Thorpe Willoughby - Brayton - Selby

Most journeys are replaced by extra trips on service 164, following requests from the community for a more frequent service to/from Leeds.

Service 64 will still run Monday to Saturday at 06:05 from Selby to Sherburn Industrial Estate, arriving at 06:45; and at 19:10 from Sherburn Industrial Estate to Selby. These journeys are designed to accommodate passengers working a 7am-7pm shift at the Industrial Estate.

Following requests from the community, services 64 and 164 will operate along Fox Lane and Field Lane in Thorpe Willoughby, and Barff Lane and Doncaster Road in Brayton. Buses will call at Selby War Memorial Hospital in both directions.

- 164 Leeds - Cross Gates - The Springs - Thorpe Park - Garforth - Micklefield - Sherburn-in-Elmet - South Milford - Monk Fryston - Thorpe Willoughby - Brayton - Selby**
- A new timetable is introduced. Service 164 will now connect Leeds and Selby every hour (currently every two hours), replacing most journeys on service 64. Sherburn Industrial Estate will continue to be served at key shift change times.
- Following requests from the community, service 164 will operate along Fox Lane and Field Lane in Thorpe Willoughby, and Barff Lane and Doncaster Road in Brayton. Buses will call at Selby War Memorial Hospital in both directions.
- 401 Selby - Abbots Road - Camblesforth - Snaith - Rawcliffe - Goole**
- The route is revised to operate via Abbots Road estate, replacing service 476 which will now operate between Selby Bus Station and Pontefract only. There will be minor changes to the timetable, and a new later journey will run Monday to Saturday following customer requests.
- 408/409 Pontefract - Darrington - Thorpe Audlin / Kirk Smeaton**
- Minor changes are made to the timetable.
- 415 York - Fulford - Escrick - Riccall - Selby**
- There are no changes to this service.
- 476 Selby - Brayton - Hensall/Whitley - Eggborough - Kellington - Beal - Knottingley - Pontefract**
- A new timetable is introduced for this service. The route will now run between Selby Bus Station and Pontefract only, with Abbots Road estate now served by service 401.
- 493 Sherburn Industrial Estate - Sherburn-in-Elmet - South Milford - Monk Fryston - Hillam - Brotherton - Byram Park - Knottingley - Pontefract**
- A new timetable is introduced for this service.
